



Full Application Testing – AKA Regression Testing

- We test each major section of ArchivesSpace to make sure that any changes to that section haven't broken existing workflows and functionality.
- Each tester gets 3-4 sections to test and we try to rotate assignments so that any one tester doesn't always get a large/complex section to test.
- We assign two testers to each section
- Each tester tests as an administrator and (preferably) with a different permission level (e.g. a basic data entry user)

Testing - Why?


- Make sure your daily workflows are not disrupted
- Learn about new options in the application
- Learn about options in ArchivesSpace that you've never used before but might be useful
- Make sure that your data remains intact and any updates don't cause issues (e.g. dates issue in latest releases)
- Find issues that may impact other users and report them.
 Help the community (JIRA!)
- Test your customizations (plugins, workflows) and update them





Testing - Benefits


- Learn about new options in the application
- Learn about options in the app that you've never used before but might be useful to your institution:
 - Evaluate how you want to use them locally
 - Inform your local users
 - Update your local documentation
 - Example: expanded agents module



Testing @ Dartmouth

- As with NYU, we test to ensure that everything works like it should. We *tend* to be a release or two behind the latest release.
- Application responsiveness
- New features
- Plugins (we have a lot). I spend a lot of time ensuring that our plugins work as expected with the latest release.
- Workflows
- I test locally first, then we have development and pre-prod instances where we test until final release in production


