





- Removed fields:
 - Rec Series and Coll numbers (not many assigned anyway ¯_(")_/¯)
 - Locations (not consistent)
 - UA or Faculty/LSC
 - SRLF sent date
 - Process status
 - Processed by
 - Target Control (???)








- □ Value.replace

 - Edit cells > Transform > Expression






- **2000 apr 1 -> 2000-04-01**
