  - Simultaneous addition of major local fine and performing art collections
  - Legacy finding aids clean up provide content for ArchivesSpace
  - Term archivist and support staff adding content daily



### The Response

- Three years of preparation for launch bred overabundance of caution in planning
  - The perfect became the enemy of the good
    - waiting for web page re-design
    - Legacy finding aid clean up
    - customizing PUI
  - Acknowledge much work yet to be done whenever we launch
  - Search for and study resources as questions arise [Lyrasis Support & ArchivesSpace community]
  - Quietly turned on during routine Lyrasis upgrade

# Marketing

- Reviewed similar launches with Marketing Director
- Defined products
  - Web banner
  - Take aways for instruction events
  - Edit PUI
  - Establish timeline of events stage announcements
- Identified audience(s)
  - Staff
  - Faculty
  - Students
  - Public

### Instruction

- Template for pilot: ArchivesSpace, Yale <u>PUI pre-launch checklist</u>
  - "Sit down with your public services staff and explore all of the new features together. Talk about what adjustments your site will want to make to the application before going live."
- August September: developing instruction session geared toward Research Services Librarians (RSL's) providing library instruction to faculty and students
  - Roll out in September to RSL's, team members & student workers
  - Identify and occupy niche in library instruction platform by November
  - Public product/presentation completed in December
  - Public events January March 2019 as described in outreach/marketing

### Incorporating feedback

- "The public interface should evolve over time based on feedback from the community and your researchers."
- Looking forward to feedback to Q&A in webinar to staff
- Prepared to answer questions from staff about missing content
- Collecting quantitative and qualitative feedback with help with this from Assessment Librarian, first for instruction, later for product
- Use feedback to assign staff resources to pin-pointed corrections while continuing updates and additions

# Instruction Design

- Base on RSL courses in library instruction
  - Describe product use to audience
  - Step-by-step walk through the product
  - Explain library support of research with original resource
  - Follow up email; formal invitation to feedback, further contact established
- Libguide for web resources
