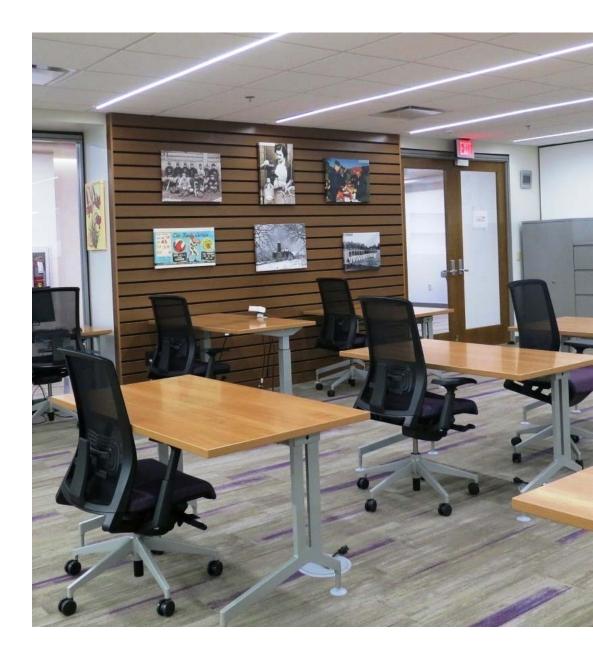

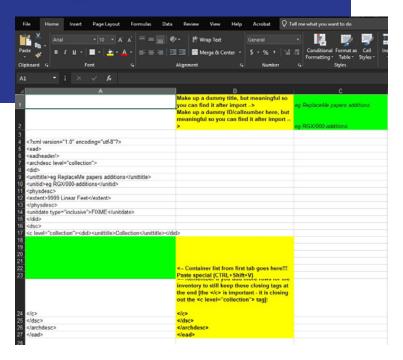

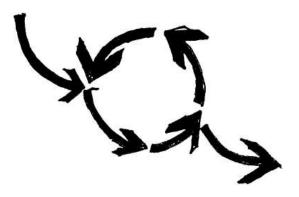
Create Manuals and Best Practices
