

The Problem

Two Tracks for Solutions

Teach users to understand archives & ArchivesSpace better

Use ArchivesSpace to maximize research capabilities

Thoughts to Consider

Who is your researcher?

- What's their experience level?
- What do they want?
- How much are they willing to invest?

What is your staff situation?

- Does each person have a specific role?
- Who do you need in the room (or on the Zoom call) to make decisions?

What's your workflow?

- Are there staff or administrative hurdles?
- Is your instance hosted?
- Do you have technical hurdles?

Ways to Help Your Researchers

Add info to your ArchivesSpace landing page or website

Primer on archives/archival terminology

Be dynamic! Add a video or PDF

Easy access to archivists - make contact info easily accessible

Describe the various entry points

Show Advanced Search options, including Boolean phases

How Can ArchivesSpace Fields Help?

Subject/Agent Records

Helps when researchers want to see all records on specific person, organization, or subject

Notes Fields

Lots of wiggle room here to add plethora of information


Accession Records

Gives context, even if Resource Records aren't available yet


